BOARDING FEES AND OTHER COSTS 2025

Boarding Application Fee – family who is resident in New Zealand. Paid with the application OR	\$50
Boarding Application Fee – family who is resident overseas but have New Zealand residency. Paid with the application	\$200
Clarice Johnstone House Acceptance Fee – paid when accepting an offer of a place	\$500
7 Night Boarding Fees for 2025 full year (charged pro rata if starting part way-see Boarding Information Book)	\$15,500
5 Night Boarding Fees for 2025 full year (charged pro rata if starting part way- see Boarding Information Book)	\$13,000
Casual Boarding Fees for 2025 (charged per night)	\$70.00

DAY-TO-DAY EXPENSES

Accounts are posted or emailed at the end of the month for the previous month's expenses.

MEDICAL ACCOUNTS

Doctor, optometrist and dental accounts are sent directly to the parent. The only exception is for those students from overseas with Medical Insurance.

SCHOOL RELATED EXPENSES

These are invoiced separately on a monthly basis from Nelson College for Girls' Finance Office. These are paid to the school and are separate from your account for Clarice Johnstone House. These school related expenses include school donation, subject fees and extras such as camps, sports and school trips. Sports fees must be paid before participation can commence.

LEAVING CJ HOUSE

Written notice to withdraw a student from boarding must be given to the Boarding Manager at least FIVE WEEKS prior to the departure date. Failure to provide the required written notice will result in five weeks boarding fees being charged.

If a student leaves during the term through the direction of the College, parents will be required to pay five weeks boarding fees from the date the student leaves CJ House.
