# Cell phone policy

As you will all no doubt have read, there is a new policy from the government which we are currently working through as a kura and will send to you once confirmed, however a reminder our current procedure for cell phone use is;

- If a student brings a phone to school, they
  must keep it in their bag on silent or in
  a designated place as directed by their
  teacher for the duration of the classroom
  day. Mobile phones are not considered as a
  BYOD (bring your own device).
- Students may only access their phone when directed to do so by their teacher and it is only to be used for teaching and learning purposes.
- If a parent/caregiver needs to contact their child URGENTLY during the day, they should call the Prep Office before 1pm and then after 1pm the NCG Student Office on 03 548 3104 ext 5. Please state if it is urgent and we will make sure the student returns your call from a school phone as soon as possible. Please do not text or ring your child during the class day.

You may also have read about the new policy from Government regarding teaching one hour a day of Reading, Writing and Maths Whilst we will and are always reviewing our curriculum to be meet student needs, we already timetable this within our 10-day timetable.
